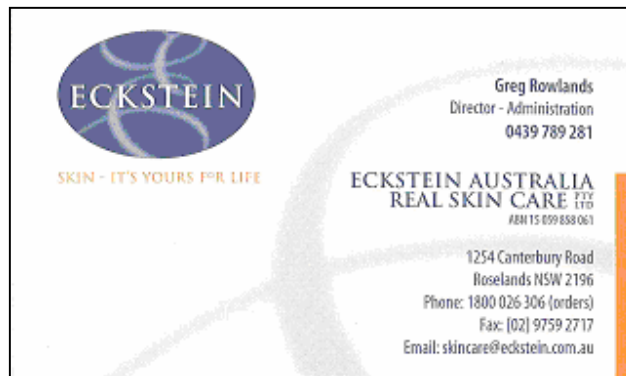

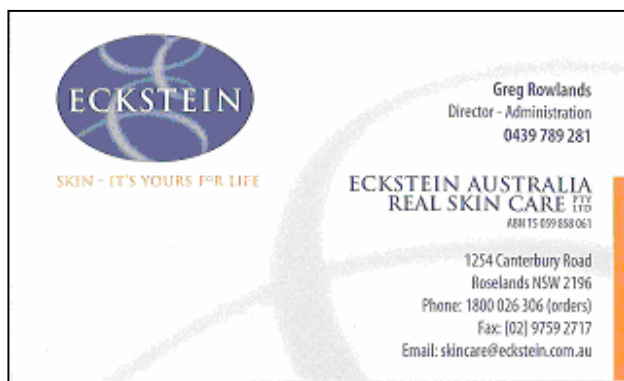

| <p>After a good performance last week against better opposition we really expected more against Sylvania, the raging favourites for the wooden spoon who only had 10 men for the entire game.</p> <p>Anyway, we started well, playing plenty of balls wide and creating genuine chances which we just couldn't seem to put away until Pete played a magnificent chip over the keeper's head after about 10 minutes for us to take the lead. Near misses in the first half included a gaping chance for Scott, a header by Watto which was just tipped out to the side by the keeper and another from Twit which he tipped onto the crossbar, a massive effort from Rich who hit the upright from about 30 metres out on an impossible angle (so unlucky!), a Watto 1on1 with the keeper sprayed wide, and we were disallowed 2 Watto goals for "supposed" offside.</p> <p>To finish the half at 1-1 gave no indication at all of how we'd played up to that point. We'd played very well in attack besides a few instances of carelessly lost possession. A bit of complacency in being first to the ball, weak challenges and some slack marking could really use some improvement to get on track defensively. We are a decent side, but we'll be a great side if we can become a bit more clinical across the board.</p> <p>The second half was similar in terms of chances created to the first, except we managed to put 3 of them away this time. The difference was we lost a lot of our width, didn't mix it up at all, and Sylvania easily diffused most our one-dimensional attacking play. Their keeper made a few miraculous saves including close range volleys from Richard and goose, as well as another 1on1 from Watto. He couldn't save them all though, Scott latching onto a great cross from Gav to control on his chest and volley home from close range, while Pete secured a hatrick slotting home 2 more goals from thru-balls.</p> <p>The final score ended up at 4-2 after Sylvania scored an un-saveable cracker of a free kick late on which Dave did well to even get a hand to.</p> <p>It was good to put another 4 goals in for the second week straight but we need to work on the defence and the actual flow of our play. 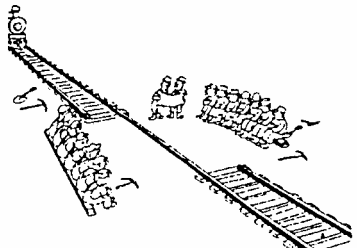
